

HWGC Holiday wreath-making workshop | Dec. 9th

You'll start with an evergreen wreath

Things to think about:

These wreaths will be 14" which is actually 24" in evergreen width

- Where will you hang your wreath?
- What color will the door, wall or fence be for your wreath to show?
- Will it need protection from the weather (glue ornamentation on or wire it)?

Materials needed:

- Scissors or pruning clippers
- Wire cutters
- Pliers
- Thin wire or green string, although wire is a bit more durable.
- Hot glue gun if desired
- Ribbon (any color, size or shape – for a bow, or to wind through your design?)
- Spray snow or spray paint, if desired

Add-in Plants:

Any evergreen plants you can find in your garden, on common land, or in your local florists.

- Small cuttings from trees or bushes like Pine, Holly, Cypress,
- Ivy (any type)
- Pinecones
- Any other interesting grasses, berries or things you find on your hunt



Ornamentation you can also get:

- Cinnamon sticks, dried apple or orange slices (or make them yourself) chestnuts, seeds, big leaves, berries, dried flowers...
- Bells, Christmas balls, Lego men, tinsel, any artificial delights that invoke Holiday joy!
